

Rotary Youth Exchange D5130 Firearms Policy

Students may shoot a firearm ONLY IF:

1. They shoot at an official shooting location* (range or indoor facility) with an on-site range master;
2. They are accompanied by an individual who has taken a firearm safety course. One student per one individual trained in firearm safety; and
3. They have approval from Rotary counselor, natural parents and host parents.

*No hunting is allowed. Nor is shooting at tin cans/watermelons, etc. on private property.

The purpose of allowing any interaction with guns at all is to permit students to understand what SAFE handling looks like so that they will recognize UNSAFE, HAZARDOUS situations and take steps to remove themselves from such situations.
